Back to School Time- Tips to Help Children Adjust

1. Be enthusiastic about school. If you are excited and confident, your child will be, too
2. Let your child become involved with packing lunch or laying out clothes. Also, establish an earlier bedtime.
3. Set aside extra time, particularly on the first day, for chatting and commuting together. But remember not to prolong the good-bye. If the child whines or clings, staying will only make it harder.
4. Always say good-bye to your child. Be firm, but friendly about separating. And once you have said good-bye, do not go back.
