We will learn important details about our friends, classmates, and ourselves. We will understand that everyone is unique and special.

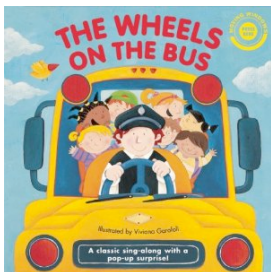

### Back to School Time- Tips to Help Children Adjust

1. Be enthusiastic about school. If you are excited and confident, your child will be, too
